**RECLASSIFYING ALL MUNICIPALITIES IN THE
PHILIPPINES**

Pursuant to the provisions of section five of Republic Act Numbered Five hundred and fifty-four, the following municipalities are hereby reclassified as indicated herein, in accordance with the schedule provided in section two thousand one hundred and seventy of the Administrative Code, as amended by section one of said Republic Act Numbered Five hundred and fifty-four, on the basis of their average annual income during the four consecutive fiscal years, ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, as certified by the General Auditing Office:
