PROCLAMATION NO. 1

DECLARING THURSDAY, JANUARY 6, 1966, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC  
HOLIDAY IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the birthday anniversary of Melchora Aquino,  
known as "Tandang Sora," famous heroine of the Revolution,  
falls on January 6, 1966; and

WHEREAS, the people of Quezon City, where Tandang Sora  
was born, should be afforded an opportunity to honor her  
with appropriate ceremonies for her humanitarian work and  
sacrifice;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of  
the Philippines, pursuant to the authority vested in me  
by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby  
declare Thursday, January 6, 1966, as a special public  
holiday in Quezon City.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and  
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be  
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 1st day of January,  
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
