[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 12271]

AN ACT DECLARING JANUARY 16 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF NAVOTAS IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDATION ANNIVERSARY


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. January 16 of every year is hereby declared a special non-working holiday in the City of Navotas in commemoration of its foundation anniversary.


SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
